Ensure that the soldiers and family members of the 28<sup>th</sup> Field Artillery are honored through a lasting tribute which is on the grounds of the Home of the Field Artillery at Fort Sill. 100% of the profit from the sale of these bricks will be applied to the cost of the monument and subsequently to the Association Scholarship program

## Brick/Paver Options

You can order a 4"x8" brick/paver for \$125 with 3 lines of 20 Characters (including spaces, comas etc). You can add clip art (unit crest, insignia or rank for example) and your cost will be \$150.00 with 16 characters per line.

You can order an 8"x8" brick/paver for \$150 with 5 lines of 20 characters. If you add clip art your cost will be \$175 with 20 characters per line.

You can also order a mini replica brick (1"x2") for \$40 (which includes shipping). This mini replica will be sent to your home address.

Once Ordered, your brick/paver will be shipped to Lawton Oklahoma where it will be professionally emplaced along with the other bricks that have been ordered around the base of our monument.
